

RNA - Restorative Nurse Aide Program

A restorative nurse aide is a certified nurse's aide who has special training in restorative nursing and rehabilitation skills. RNA helps residents regain their health, strength and independence.

The program may involve measures that promotes self-care, B&B training, positioning, mobility, communication, and cognitive functions.

Program consists of lectures, skills, video presentations, student hands-on and participation exercises.

CNA Certified Nurse Assistant

Nursing assistant provides basic nursing care under the supervision of a licensed nurse. There is a need for certified nurse assistants all over the United States. Hospitals, skilled nursing facilities, home health agencies require nursing assistants to have a formal training and to pass competency evaluations. In becoming a Licensed Adult Residential Care Home requires a work experience as a nurse assistant for 1 year. It is also a stepping stone to LPN and RN Professions.
